If you have entered any of the following VNAM competitions, you must adhere to the General Rules for your entry to be valid.

For Veterinary Nurses;

**Category A | Veterinary Nurse Recipe Poster** - Design a digital poster showing the “ingredients” and “recipe” needed to make a Veterinary Nurse.

**Category B | Virtual Bake Off** – Organise a themed virtual bake off with colleagues and clients.

**Category C | Recruitment Poster** - Design a digital poster to encourage individuals to join the Veterinary Nursing profession.

**Category D | Virtual Event** – Organise a virtual event in practice with colleagues and clients.

For Pet Owners;

**Category E for Pet Owners |** Take a picture of your pet and complete the sentence “I love my Veterinary Nurse because....”

### General Rules:

- Competition entries must be emailed to [bvna@bvna.co.uk](mailto:bvna@bvna.co.uk) no later than **Monday 31st May 2021**
- Entries will **not** be accepted if they are not emailed to us
- RVNs and SVNs should be wearing uniform, RCVS badges and if a member of the BVNA, your BVNA badge, if you have it.
- Permission must be obtained for any person shown and from the owner of any animal shown
- You **must** include our partner logos on your poster which are provided for you here
- You **must** include these hashtags on your poster; #planetRVN, #VNAM2021 and #whatVNsdo
- You must not use BVNA’s images and logo without permission from BVNA. We would recommend that you should find your own images, as this will help to make your content more unique!
- Please note that items entered into a competition can be used for promotional purposes by BVNA at any time
- Social media posts and photos must be posted on our dedicated VNAM Facebook page, and on your own social media channels, using the hashtags; #planetRVN, #VNAM2021 and #whatVNsdo
- Winners will be notified in June and will be listed on the BVNA website and social media channels
